

Rules for "Fall for All Festival" Scarecrow Contest: All Employees, Companies, and People attending Programs may enter. Please print and fill out registration form and email form to fallscarecrowcontest@ahrc.org no later than September 8th, 2023. All Scarecrows must be weather resistant and constructed to withstand the weather and natural elements. Scarecrows will remain on display until November 1st, 2023. No perishable goods including real pumpkins, squash etc. may be used or placed on the ground. Plastic pumpkins, gourds etc. are acceptable. All Scarecrows should be built on a fencepost, which will be provided (pickup in Plainview 9/6, 9/7 and 9/8 10-2) as they will be mounted in the ground for display and should be able to freely stand. Please leave a space of 12 inches at the bottom of the fence post for mounting. Please bring a photocopy of your registration form to hand in when picking up your fence post. Scarecrow entries must not be wider than 4 feet wide. Scarecrows should be labeled with your team/site name and contact number on the back of your display. Entries must be dropped off at 211 Wheatley Farms and Arts on Tuesday September 19th or Wednesday September 20th from 10am to 2:30pm. All entries will be assigned a number at drop off and it will be attached to your Scarecrow. A map of your Scarecrow's location by number will be posted on the day of the event. Winners will be selected in the following categories: Most Creative, Most Agency Spirit, Best Fall Themed and Most Haunted as well as our top Scarecrow in both the Employee and Program Entries.
